ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Products must have received marketing approval in the UK by 31st December, 2022, but not more than five years earlier than 31st December of that year (unless the awards is for a new/innovative indication added within the past five years). We accept applications for individual products, not classes of products, as well as orphan submissions within each category.
